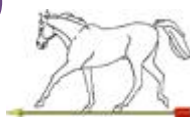

Rounds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WA70: 6 dozen arrows at 70m, doubled. • WA60: 6 dozen arrows at 60m, doubled: for junior or 50+ archers. • WA50: 6 dozen arrows at 50m, doubled: for compound or barebow archers. <p>Please note that this shoot offers Double WA rounds only – no single rounds are offered.</p>
Event Timing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registration: 08:00. • Equipment Inspection: 08:15. • Assembly: 08:45. • Sighters: 09:00. • Shooting: 09:30. <p>Please be sure to bring your Archery GB Membership card for inspection.</p>
Event Format	<p>All bosses will be layered foam bosses, and there will be 4 archers per boss for all rounds.</p> <p>Shooting will be in timed ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes, in 2 details.</p> <p>Recurve, Longbow and Barebow archers will shoot on 122cm faces.</p> <p>Compound archers will shoot on individual 80cm 6-zone faces.</p>
Last Entry Date	Sunday 26 th July, 2026.
Awards	<p>DWAA Medal Policy (unless otherwise stated), including over 50 categories.</p> <p>A team award will also be available for mixed teams of 4 archers, which must include 1 lady or 1 gent, with one compound archer permitted per team.</p>

Dress Code	<p>All competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations.</p> <p>Any archer not complying with these regulations will not be permitted to shoot.</p> <p>For further details, please refer to Archery GB's Rules of Shooting (Rule 307). The latest version of the rules of shooting can be found under the 'Member Resources' tab of your Sport80 account.</p>
Refreshments	<p>A selection of cakes and pastries will be available throughout the day, as well as hot and cold drinks.</p> <p>Note: Kingston Archers is a cash-only site.</p>
Photography	<p>Anyone wishing to take photos or videos at the event must first sign the photo register, which will be located at the archer registration station.</p> <p>By attending the shoot, you consent to appear in photographs taken by those on the photo register.</p>
Car Parking	<p>Parking is available on-site, and our volunteers will direct you to an appropriate space on arrival.</p>
Lost Arrows	<p>All lost arrows must be reported to the Field Captain.</p> <p>It is the archer's responsibility to find any missing arrows before leaving the range, so please make sure that your arrows can be detected with a metal detector, and we'll assist you with this.</p>
Dogs	<p>Dogs are not permitted on the premises.</p>
Smoking	<p>Smoking is not permitted on the Kingston Archers range.</p>
Liability	<p>Please be aware that neither Kingston Archers, GWAS, DWAA, nor the owners of the venue accept any liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred at this event/location, howsoever caused.</p>
